The Tenant Coordinators currently have payment plans in good standing with 33 current tenants. The Tenant Coordinators follow the Eviction Prevention Policy to minimize the amount of arrears.

<sup>i</sup> The percentage of arrears is calculated as the difference between total rents, housing charges and other charges charged to households and the total actually received from households, divided by the total charged, expressed as a percentage. This formula for arrears calculation is the definition of the Social Housing Services Corporation used for calculating arrears as an indicator of performance.

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
