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Bruce County : Bruce County Transportation and Environment Services is currently monitoring all roads and bridges under its' jurisdiction for flooding and structural integrity.

Currently, for the safety of travelers, the Chesley Main Street Bridge located on Bruce Road 30 in Chesley has been closed indefinitely due to structural damage caused by flood waters. Detours have been set up at Bruce Road 19 and Bruce Road 10 to reroute traffic. The Department is aware of the high waters at the Teeswater River Bridge in Paisley on Bruce Road 3. We continue to monitor and work with the Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority and are preparing detour plans should conditions warrant.

Bruce Road 1 in Paisley from Duke Street to Wellington Street remains closed at this time.

Please exercise caution when traveling over roadways, bridges and culverts.
