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**Bruce County:** Bruce County Transportation and Environmental Services continues to monitor all roads and bridges under its' jurisdiction for flooding and structural integrity.

The County has been in constant communications with County Officials, Structural Engineers, Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority, and local municipalities in regards to the Chesley Main Street Bridge on Bruce Road 30 (1<sup>st</sup> Avenue) and the Teeswater River Bridge on Bruce Road 3 in Paisley. The Chesley Main Street Bridge has significant structural damage which has warranted the closure. This bridge is closed indefinitely to all vehicular traffic, however at this time pedestrian traffic is permissible. In the near future, signage will be placed to reflect this. The County is organizing engineers to inspect the bridge to determine the next course of action.

There are high water levels at the Teeswater River Bridge on Bruce Road 3 in Paisley and as such the bridge will be monitored through the night and an update of any closures will be provided through our website at [www.brucecounty.on.ca/road-conditions](http://www.brucecounty.on.ca/road-conditions).
