Bruce County:

As of 9:52 AM 24 February 2018 in consultation with the Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority Bruce County is no longer undertaking 24 hour monitoring at the Teeswater River Bridge on Bruce Road 3 in Paisley. Periodic monitoring will continue.

The Chesley Main Street Bridge on Bruce Road 30 (1st Ave) in Chesley remains closed indefinitely to vehicular traffic, including pedestrian traffic.

Bruce Road 1 in Paisley from Duke St. to Wellington St. IS NOW OPEN.
