

Westario Power Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP)

The Westario Power Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP) is a grant program intended to provide emergency relief to eligible low-income customers who may be having difficulty paying their current hydro arrears. It is for emergency situations only and is not meant to provide you with ongoing help to pay your bills.

Eligible customers can get **up to \$650** in emergency assistance for your electricity bills (**\$780** if your home is heated electrically).

To be eligible to apply you must:

- Be an existing Westario Power customer;
- Live at the address where there are arrears;
- Be in arrears and at risk of having your service shut off (disconnected); and
- Have an after-tax income at or below the amounts listed in the chart below.

What you need to include with your application?

- Current Westario Power bill;
- Notice of Service Disconnection, if applicable;
- Applicant Identification two pieces of I.D. for the main applicant, and 1 piece of I.D. for all other household members;
- Copy of rental receipt, lease (or letter from Landlord) or mortgage document.
- Proof of household income: and
- Bank statement from the most recent month.
